



Limited Warranty For Standby Power Grid Tie Applications

Fullriver Battery Company warrants any battery used in Standby Power Applications which becomes un-serviceable due to defect in material and/or workmanship (not merely discharged) under the terms & conditions stated below. This warranty applies to the original purchaser of the battery and is non-transferable and is only valid for products sold in North America (United States, and Canada).

WARRANTY EXCLUSIONS

Fullriver Battery Company will not be responsible for any expenses for transportation, installation, recharging, electrical system tests, loss of time, loss of use of equipment, or other expenses which would be considered as incidental or consequential damages.

THE PROVISIONS OF THIS LIMITED WARRANTY SHALL NOT APPLY TO:

The battery must only be used in Standby applications. A standby power application is considered an application where the power grid is the primary power source and batteries are provided strictly for when grid power is unavailable to a service provider outage. Other exclusions would include: Improper installation/maintenance/or charging (undercharging or overcharging), rusted/corroded/ or improper hardware, abuse or neglect (i.e. loose wiring), exposure to excessive heat or cold temperatures (i.e. freezing, fire, explosion, etc), shipping damage, use or storage of the battery in an uncharged condition, discharged batteries, improperly sized battery sets (over or under), batteries damaged from electrical equipment, or if the manufacturing codes have been destroyed or tampered with.

You will need to provide proof of purchase along with the manufacturing code for the batteries. The Standby Power Applications Limited Warranty starts from the date sold and applies only to Standby Power applications. During the free replacement period, the battery will be repaired or replaced with a similar or one of equal value. Pro-ration is based on manufacturer's suggested retail price using the formula below:

Fullriver Battery Company makes no express warranties with respect to its batteries other than the limited warranties stated above. All implied warranties are limited to the duration of periods & conditions set forth above.
